

Baker County 4-H Livestock Club Market Requirements

If you are going to participate in the 2017 market projects, you must follow all required guidelines. This year market participants will be required to do the following:

- Be enrolled in 4Honline by May 31st & re-enroll (begins September 1st)
- Turn in commitment forms by May 31st
- Participate in County Events February 25th (Everyone is encouraged to do more than a framed picture, but will not be required) must register for county events by February 22 at florida.4honline.com, youth do not have to be present at county events if they are only doing a framed picture.
- Help with fundraisers for the livestock club
- Attend 75% of club meetings April-September (worth 4 points)
- Turn in at least four stamped and unsealed invitations to potential buyers for the market sale at the fair (leaders will mail them)
- Turn in project book at the end of project, to the Extension Office (worth 5 points)
 - Due on the 1st Monday of September
- Turn in points sheet (15 points) at the end of project, to the Extension Office
 - Due the 1st Monday of September
- Attendance at mandatory meetings
- Fair record book completion, due Monday of the fair at the fairgrounds
- Once the project is complete and the animal has sold at the fair each child will receive a list of their buyers and add-ons, each child must hand write thank you letters to the buyers and add-ons by November 30th from the fair board (buyer letters need to be hand written and add-on letters may be typed).

I understand and agree to follow all requirements to show a market animal at county fairs. I understand that if I do not follow all requirements, my 4-H Leaders and Extension Agent will consider me ineligible to show at the Baker County Fair with my market animal.
