

Baker County 4-H Requirements for Youth Show Animal Projects

As of September 1, 2015 youth ages 8 and older wanting to show animals (commercial beef, horse, market steer and swine, pullets, rabbits, goats and poultry) in the fair will be required to earn a minimum of 15 points. Youth 5-7 need 10 points. These points will be earned by participating in club, county, district, and state level 4-H events & activities. This system has been developed to help 4-H youth become well rounded program participants.

A list of opportunities to earn points is provided. Agent signature is required to verify your participation and this sheet must be submitted the first Monday of September to the 4-H Office. When points are achieved, please give a copy of your points to Mrs. Shaina. Please don't hesitate to contact your 4-H agent with questions regarding these requirements. Remember to sign in at ALL events/meetings. This will help in case point forms are lost. It is not the responsibility of the 4-H office to keep track of points.

- Fair Home arts entries (1 point per youth, not entry)

- Holiday Party (1 point)
- Hog and Ham (4 points)
- County and District STEM Fair (2 points each)
- 4-H Day at the Capitol (2 points)
- Introducing Cool Experiences, I.C.E. (ages11-13) (2 points)
- Third Executive Board (Senior aged youth only) (2 points)
- County, district or state level events:
- Poster contest (1 point)
- Photography contest (1 point)
- Public speaking (speech, demonstration or illustrated talk) (3 points)
- Share the Fun Talent Show (2 points)
- Fashion Revue (1 point)
- Help with Association Auction (1 point)
- Summer day camps (2 points)
- Overnight camp (Camp Cherry Lake) or state camp (shooting sports, marine, etc.) (4 points)
- 4-H Legislature (3 points)
- 4-H University (3 points)
- County Awards Program (1 point)
- Leadership Adventure Weekend (2 points)
- County/District Clinics or Workshops (1 point)
- Completed 4-H Project book (5 points) (This is not the Fair Record Book)
- Completed 4-H Record Book (6 points) (Details in Baker County 4-H Manual)
- Share at a club meeting (how to make something, groom an animal, etc.) (3 points)
- Being a club officer (2 points)
- Camp Counselor (2 points)
- Lead a club activity/project (1 point)
- Recruit a new member (1 point) List their name on your sheet
- County or District Council Meetings (District-2 points, County-1 point) (max 4 points)
- Attend Community Service Project (1 point per event)
- Attend club meetings (max of 4 points per 4-H year)

Points can be awarded for activities not listed at the discretion of the agent
